We will be holding the Halloween Spooktacular again this year on Oct. 31st from 5:00-7:00 outside the building, with pictures being taken for the Boone County Journal on the stage. There will be a costume competition starting at 6:00, with prizes awarded that evening.

Since there was no Breakfast meeting this morning, this will be a quick report, but there is vital information. There will be no Bingo on Nov. 4th because of staffing issues and the building is rented Nov. 5th, so there will be no Breakfast meeting again in two weeks. Bingo will return Nov. 11th and 18th to avoid the Thanksgiving weekend.

(NOTE: The following paragraph added by your website editor to correct and expand on info re: the upcoming general election)

Elections are Nov.8. The new law in effect since Aug 28 now requires a Missouri or Federally issued photo ID (driver's license, non-driver's license, passport, military ID) which is unexpired or which expired since the last general election on Nov 2, 2020.. NOTE: Southern Boone will have two additional polling places on Nov 8 Precinct 30 votes at the YMCA building and precinct 35 at the Ashland Christian Church on Hwy M at DD (just west of town. Our Optimist Club building and the Ashland Senior Center will handle all the other Southern Boone precincts. Check your mailed election notification carefully to find your polling **place!** Also, there are four Central Polling Places where you can vote regardless of which precinct you live in: The BoCo Gov't Center 9th and Ash, the Hearnes Center, Woodcrest Chapel on Nifong and Friendship Baptist on Smiley Lane. The new law also allows for early-no-excuse-absentee voting at the BoCo Gov't Center from Oct 25 through Nov 7 (including weekends) PLUS Saturday, Nov 5 from 10a to 3p in Ashland at the Southern Boone Library.
